Job Duties: Agency Specific Minimum Qualifications: Provides administrative supervision and educational leadership to the Pre-K - 12 academic program and related extracurricular programs.

By: Developing and implementing policies, programs, and lesson planning; supervising educational programming, including lesson development/implementation, instruction, assessment, and parent involvement; providing administrative leadership for educational programs; developing, implementing, and monitoring the CCIP Grant; directing daily management of the school; coaching, counseling and disciplining teachers and support staff in accordance with OSD policies and procedures; assisting in the planning, monitoring and appraising of job results; recruiting, selecting, orienting and training teachers and staff; supervising faculty and staff; identifying short-term and long-range issues that must be addressed; researching and disseminating pertinent information (e.g., identification, evaluation, parent education, language development, transition programming for services after graduation, etc.); establishing collaborative partnerships with community agencies in the Central Ohio region to implement all program components; Providing parents with academic information, suggesting available educational and social resources; addressing parents' concerns; answering questions and requests; serving as a member of the superintendent's administrative team; establishing personal rapport with educators, parents, students, and other persons in a position to understand educational requirements; surveying operational and educational conditions; recommending and taking actions; attending educational workshops; reviewing professional publications; establishing personal networks; participating in professional societies; keeping abreast of education opportunities for deaf students throughout Ohio; submitting an annual Individual Professional Development Plan for review and approval by the LPDC; participating in faculty meetings, school committees, educational conferences, and/or professional training days.

Qualifications:

Must maintain valid Ohio educational certification/licensure as a principal; know the laws (IDEA, NCLB, Ohio's Operating Standards and Related Guidance for Ohio Educational Agencies Serving Children with Disabilities).

Must demonstrate intermediate level of ASL on SLPI rating within 2 years of hire.

Conditions for Employment: Employment is contingent upon successful completion of FBI and BCI criminal background checks. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use.
